
What are the top 10 Jobs if you like work in Geography related careers?

Study the Earth's structure and formation, and analyse rocks to explore its natural mineral and energy resources.

Collect measurements and data used throughout the planning and construction



Organise the storage and distribution of goods

Organise and plan the extraction of natural resources, such as metals, diamonds, coal, salt, clay and granite, from the earth.

Promote tourism and attract visitors to a particular region.

Protect and enhance the local environment by working with the public and local organisations
