



Frequently asked questions – Student Life – Study Abroad & A Year in Industry

Below you'll find answers to the questions we get asked most:

If I study abroad do I have to study at a different university?

No, there are many options as to what to do when on your wear abroad. You can get a job, teach English as a second language or study at a different university if you wish to.

Do you have to know a different language to study abroad? No, there are many options for studying abroad in a English speaking country.

Can you only study abroad if you are studying a language? No, there are many opportunities to study abroad no matter what course you are studying.

Does it cost a lot to study abroad? Costs can vary but there is a lot of financial support for those studying abroad to ensure everyone is able to take up the opportunity.

Do you have to find your own placement for a year in industry?

This can vary between universities but there is always a lot of support available for the careers team within the university to help you find the right placement for you.

Do you get paid if you do a year in industry?

This can vary between each placement and so it is worth looking early so you have the best chance of securing the right one for you.

Are you guaranteed a job at the company if you take a year in industry?

You are not guaranteed a job for when you graduate from your placement company but it is not unusual to be offered one.

Is your year abroad assessed?

Again, this can vary between universities. Sometimes you will be asked to write an essay on your experience or if you are studying at a different university, you may sit exams at the university as part of the course.
