**Travel Agent**

Research, plan, and book trips for individuals and groups, help with flight bookings, hotel selection, transfer arrangements, and holiday activities

**Hotel/hospitality  
receptionist**

Oversee all aspects of running a hotel – from housekeeping and general maintenance to budget management and marketing of the hotel

**Waiting on staff**

Work in restaurants, cafes and hotels, taking orders from customers and serving their food and drinks.

**Bartender**

Works in pubs, clubs, wine bars, cafe bars or hotels, serving drinks, food and snacks to members of the public.

**Hotel Manager**

Oversee all aspects of running a hotel – from housekeeping and general maintenance to budget management and marketing of the hotel.

**Front of House assistant**

Roles that involve direct customer interaction. Whether you're meeting and greeting, providing table service or serving drinks, you are performing a front-facing role and directly

**Spa manager**

**Responsible for the day-to-day running of health and/or beauty spas. They manage a spa's finances, employees, and services.**

**Event and Conference organiser**

**Co-ordinate every detail of meetings and conferences, from the speakers and meeting locations to the printed materials and audio-visual equipment.**

**Have expert knowledge of specific areas, including natural features, historic sites, museums. Guides may give walking tours, bus tours, or even boat tours**

**Responsible for every aspect of the day-to-day management of a leisure centre, organising health and fitness programmes**
