- 1. How many people in the UK are employed on zero hours contracts?
- a) 500,000 b) 1m c) 2m. However, there are many people working on part time hours and as self-employed who may be classed as part of the gig economy. To try and find a more stable and well-paying job students should put into practice the employability equation (see next question)
- 2. What do the letters stand for in this equation $E = (Q + S + WE) \times C$?
 - E -= Employability
 - Q = Qualifications
 - S= Skills
 - WE = Work Experience
 - C = Contacts
 - O = Opportunities
- 3. How many different businesses are there in the LCR?
 - a) 45, 261 b) 47,064 c) 49,125 (most are Small and Medium Sized Enterprises)
- 4. Which sector employs the most people in the LCR
 - a) Human Health Activities (71, 980 but if you added in residential social care (16,710) and social work activities (22, 050) this would be the biggest employing sector
 - b) Creative and Digital (22,000)
 - c) Professional and Business Services (107,000)
- 5. How many people work in the Visitor Economy in the LCR?
- a) 45,000 b) 52,000 c) 61,000
- 6. Name 3 good reasons to go to university
 - You can pick from thousands of courses
 - Getting a degree will leave your career choice more open ended in terms of future opportunities
 - You'll acquire a whole range of soft skills, transferable to any job role
 - For some jobs you have to have a degree

 - Be trained in the skills that employers want
 - Learn at a pace that suits you
 - Be supported by a mentor
 - Have paid holidays
