

## What are the top 10 Jobs if you like work in Media Studies careers?

**Media Planner**

Identify which media platforms would best advertise a client's brand or product.

**Multimedia specialist**

Design and develop multimedia applications, systems and products that entertain, educate, persuade or inform the user.

**Programme Researcher**

Involves organising, planning and researching everything that will happen during a programme

**Public Relations Officer**

Is about managing reputation. It involves gaining understanding and support for your clients, as well as trying to influence opinion and behaviour.

**Runner for Film, TV**

Is an entry-level position, the most junior role in the production department of a broadcast, film or video company.

**Event Manager**

Manage the whole process from the planning stage, right through to running the actual day itself and the post-event evaluation

**Production Assistant**

**Support producers in making film or TV programmes.**

**Sound Recordist**

**Responsible for recording the voices and background noise on TV studio and film shoots.**

**Marketing Assistant**

**Think of creative ways to promote their employer's products, or services such as planning, advertising, public relations and sponsorship.**

**UX designer**

**Involved in designing sites and software for specific target groups based on User Experiences**
