

## What are the top 10 Jobs if you like work in Performing Arts careers?

**Actor/Dancer**

use speech, movement and expression to bring characters to life in theatre, film, television and radio

**Community Arts Worker**

help local communities plan and take part in activities like drama, dance, painting, and photography.

**Drama therapist**

use group work, role-play and movement to help people with their feelings and emotions

**Secondary School Teacher**

teach children from 11 to 16, or up to 19 in schools with sixth forms

**Runner**

work behind the scenes, doing small jobs and basic tasks to help the production run smoothly

**TV/Film/Theatre Director**

lead the creative and technical production for cinema and television

**Theatre Stage  
Manager**

**makes sure the sets, equipment and props are ready for the opening of a performance.**

**Arts administrator**

**organise cultural activities and events like arts festivals.**

**Music therapist**

**use music/sound to help improve people's emotional well being, relieve stress and improve confidence.**

**Broadcast presenter**

**work in television and radio introducing and hosting programmes, interviewing people and reporting on issues and events.**
