

## What are the top 10 Jobs if you like work in Psychology careers?

**Clinical psychologist**

Your aim is to reduce the distress and improve the psychological well-being of your clients.

**Counselling psychologist**

Use psychological theory and research in therapeutic work to help clients with a variety of problems.

**Educational psychologist**

Help children or young people who are experiencing problems that hinder their successful learning

**Forensic psychologist**

You relate to the assessment and treatment of criminal behaviour, working with prisoners and offenders

**Further education teacher**

You will teach a range of subjects in one of three main areas: vocational training, academic teaching, basic skills

**Health psychologist**

Work with patients with varying psychological or physical health issues and manage the psychological aspects of their illness.

**High intensity therapist**

You'll support individuals who are experiencing mental health conditions, in particular moderate to severe depression and anxiety

**Occupational psychologist**

You'll apply knowledge, theory and practice to organisational issues in the workplace, such as culture and change, as well as issues at an individual or team level

**Primary care graduate mental health worker**

You provide a range of treatments, support and advice to people suffering from common mental health issues, such as anxiety and panic attacks

**Psychological wellbeing practitioner**

Support individuals who are experiencing common mental health difficulties such as mild to moderate symptoms of depression, anxiety and low mood
