

## What are the top 10 Jobs if you would like to work in Religious Education?

**Secondary school teacher**

**Teach children from 11 to 16, or up to 19 in schools with sixth forms**

**Charity Officer**

**Works for a non-profit organisation, also be known as a charity administrator, community liaison officer or project development officer**

**Advice Worker**

**Provide free, impartial and confidential advice and information on issues such as finance and housing**

**Counsellor**

**Help people to explore feelings and emotions that are often related to their experiences.**

**Civil Service**

**Are involved in tasks, such as researching and analysing policy options, drafting material that will be used as the basis for new legislation**

**International Relations Officer**

**Supports the development of relationships with governments, embassies and businesses.**

**Social Worker**

**Help to protect vulnerable children and adults from harm or abuse, and support people to live independently.**

**Youth & Community Worker**

**Guide and support young people aged 11 to 25. They organise activities to help with personal and social development**

**Immigration Officer**

**Check and monitor people entering and leaving the country**

**Conference Organiser**

**Organisers plan and run events like trade shows, conferences and exhibitions.**
