The support from Sally Beevers and Gill Walsh has enabled us to reflect upon current practice and in particular develop: online tracking tools, effective evaluation, and ways to strengthen links with employers (through Wirral Chamber). In addition, they have enabled us to improve our tracking of individual pupils' provision and our work with HEIs (being 11-16, this was in need of development).

Wirral Chamber (especially the Young Chamber) have been excellent. They have undertaken assemblies with the children, and these have ranged from motivational, to exploring the local labour market. In addition, we have undertaken a number of visits to local FE providers, which we have not before in school time, with groups of children in Year 10 (often 50-70 in a group). School has also engaged with the Transformational Trust to support aspects of the CEIAG programme
