This term the range of work has included:

#### Follow up of year 11 students:

Phone calls home have been made to find out the intended destinations of some students and to offer information and support, where needed. Alongside school staff, a home visit has been done and also visits to some students in alternative provision. A parent of a year 11 student also came into school to meet with us about the student's intended destination. This term, I also accompanied some year 10 students on a visit to Cheshire

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College and have carried out group sessions with all year 10 form groups, helping the students to get to know the careers adviser, ready for year 11.

### Summary:

- 93% of students found the session to be extremely, very or quite useful.
- Having a member of school staff in the sessions was helpful, in terms of managing behaviour
- Some student comments suggest a mix of expectations of the session and what it might offer them.
