- This term has mainly been focused on year 10 students. Following on from year 10 group sessions, an evaluation was completed with all students. The majority of these were very positive. There were 2 students who highlighted problems with understanding all of the information given out in groups. I was able to see these students individually, which gave me the opportunity to discuss their individual needs. This was a successful follow-up to the group sessions.
- Two year 7 students referred themselves for careers appointments. It was useful to be able to promote my role to younger students and to be able to give them an insight into the careers guidance process in school as well as give them information on their current career ideas.
